3. **WAIVER AND RELEASE** – I/We hereby waive any and all claims, past, present, or future, known, or unknown of any kind of nature, for personal injury (including death) arising out of or connected with the hereinabove-named minor's participation at Victory Gymnastics' facilities and I/We hereby release The Hope Foundation for Aspiring Youth dba Victory Gymnastics, its officers, directors, agents and employees from any and all such claims.
4. **COVENANT NOT TO SUE** – I/We hereby covenant and agree not to sue, nor to assist any other person or legal entity, in suing Victory Gymnastics, its officers, directors, agents, and employees or on account of any such claim described in paragraph 3 above.
5. **INDEMNIFICATION** – I/We hereby covenant and agree to hold harmless and indemnify The Hope Foundation for Aspiring Youth dba Victory Gymnastics, its officers, directors, agents, and employees described in paragraph 3 hereof made by or on behalf of any person or legal entity, including court costs, expert witness fees, and reasonable fees.
6. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF NO PHYSICAL EVALUATION BY VICTORY GYMNASTICS** – I/We hereby acknowledge The Hope Foundation for Aspiring Youth dba Victory Gymnastics will make no evaluation or recommendation as to whether or not the hereinabove-named minor is physically fit or any exercise activity, and that if such minor has any physical condition that may impact upon his/her ability to engage in these activities, and/or which condition may be aggravated or exacerbated by these activities, it is my/our responsibility to obtain a physicians' statement describing any limitation to participate in the programs, activities, and/or to make use of the equipment and facilities. I/We further acknowledge that it is always advisable to consult with a physician prior to allowing said minor to undertake any physical exercise program.
7. **NO LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE TO VEHICLES.**
VICTORY GYMNASTICS shall not be liable for damage to any vehicle using the parking facilities including theft, collision, fire or any other damage to vehicles; Victory Gymnastics shall not be responsible for articles left in such vehicles; Victory Gymnastics shall not be liable for loss of use of any such vehicles which may be damaged while using the parking facilities. In addition, Victory Gymnastics shall not be liable for any injury to any person using the parking facilities regardless of the cause of such injury; all persons using the parking facilities shall do so at their own risk. Patrons, visitors and guests shall indemnify and hold Victory Gymnastics and its agents harmless from all loss, damage, liability, cost or expense incurred, suffered, or claimed by any person or entity by reason of injury, loss or damage to any person, property, or business resulting from negligence or negligent or unlawful use of the parking facilities.



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8. **SEPERABILITY** – If any section, paragraph, sentence, or clause of the agreement is determined or declared to be invalid unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

10. **GOVERNING LAW** – This agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Oklahoma notwithstanding the fact one or more parties may become a resident of another state.
